

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NEED FOR  
LOW-RENT HOUSING IN THE CITY OF EAU  
GALLIE, COUNTY OF BREVARD, FLORIDA.

Whereas, there exists in the City of Eau Gallie, Florida a need for low-rent  
Housing and the Brevard County Housing Authority is applying pursuant  
to the provisions of the United States Housing, October 4th, 1937, as  
amended for a Preliminary Loan to cover costs of survey and planning  
for low-rent Housing Projects in said City.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Eau Gallie,  
County of Brevard, Florida:

1. that insanitary and unsafe inhabited dwelling accommodations exist  
in the City of Eau Gallie, Florida. It shall be unlawful for  
any person to occupy an automobile trailer as living quarters
2. that there is a shortage of safe and sanitary dwelling accommoda-  
tions in the City of Eau Gallie, Florida available to persons of  
low income rentals they can afford.
3. that aforesaid conditions can be best remedied through the exer-  
cise of the powers of the Housing Authority of Brevard County,  
Florida within the territorial boundaries of the City, and there-  
fore there is a need for the Authority to exercise these powers  
within the City.

4. that the governing body approves the application of the Housing  
Authority for a Preliminary Loan in the amount not to exceed \$10,000.00  
to cover costs of surveys and planning in connection with the devel-  
opment of not to exceed approximately 100 units of low-rent housing  
in the City of Eau Gallie, Florida and declares its intention to enter  
into a Cooperation Agreement with the Housing Authority pursuant to  
the United States Housing Act of 1937, as amended.

If the above would accomplish what you have in mind  
The Resolution was passed and adopted at a Special Adjourned meeting held on this  
17th. day of December 1951.
